We offer a glimpse into the myriad initiatives that keep The Orbis School, Keshav Nagar, dynamicthroughoutthe year as we present the school's annual report.

Like any other year, this year too, our class 12 students made us very proud with a 100% pass result. Out of the batch, 24% of the students scored more than 90% and 60% of the students passed with distinction.

- Our Science toppers were Liu Runbang with 96%, followed by Shreyas Pansare and Kartik Lad, both scoring 95.6% and Neha Vardharajan, 95%
- Oma Shailendra Sharma topped the Commerce batch with 93%, and both Saumya Kapil and Jeet Pawan Guptawere a close second with 92.2%.
- The Humanities stream topper was Yashvi Desai with 96%, Kanakdeep Kaur with 94.8% and both Abhilash Kar and Annwesha Mukherjee trailed closely with 94.4%

In addition, our class 10 batch passed with flying colours. with 52% of the students scoring above 90% and 35% scoring above 75%. Aayushi Kumar brought laurels to herself and the school with a score of 99%. Jhanvi Sanjana Pendyala placed second with 98.4%, followed by Samanwita Chattopadhyay and Ayush Biswas, both tied for the third position with 98.20%. A total of 400 teams across India participated in the Virtual event. They qualified for the National round with a regional rank of 14 out of 200 teams.

Class 9 and 10 students actively engaged in a series of diverse competitions, showcasing their talents and skills at various events. Students participated in the Patwardhan Dabate hosted by The Bishop's School, Camp, engaging in insightful

discussions on relevant topics.

The students also joined the Third Edition of Project Veer Gatha organised by CBSE, showcasing their creativity and innovation. This diverse participation not only provided a platform for students to express their abilities but also enriched their overall learning experience, fostering a spirit of competition and collaboration in various domains. Overall, the students of the Orbis School are making the most of their opportunities and excelling in various fields.

The adage that a healthy mind resides in a healthy body has become a reality, as our young athletes are always ready to compete. Events like UN Yoga Day, Khelo India and the FIT India Campaign helped to improve the fitness of the children.

The NCC program has flourished, and a new cohort of students has been enrolled. In addition, the graduating batch has demonstrated outstanding performance and excellence in their examinations. They successfully attended a 10-day camp held at the NCC Pune Headquarters of the 3rd Maha Air Squadron. The result of the Certificate examination taken by our 1st batch of students has been exceptional with most of themscoring 'A' grades.

Sports has always been an integral part of the Orbis School. The showcase event, Orbisports, honoured those who performed well with certificates and medals. The students of classes 1 to 5 stood out with their Karate, Pyramids, Dumbbells and Bamboo Drills, showcasing sportsmanship and team spirit. In various sports competitions, our school has demonstrated commendable achievements.

- In cricket, our Under-17 boys reached the quarter-finals in the DSO sports competitions.
